Scott May welcomed the committee members to the ELISA Summit committee meeting and introduced Marie-Ange as the committee chairperson. Scott oriented (through screensharing) the committee members to the web-based resources. Scott asked the committee members to go the website www.icpdprograms.org, select "Committees" from the "Select an ICPD site" drop-down menu at the top right side of the page. Scott told the committee members that they could locate the meeting agendas, past meeting notes and supporting documents for the meeting on the ELISA Summit Committee Tab. Marie-Ange led the committee through the agenda for the Committee.

Marie-Ange then invited everyone on the call to introduce themselves.

Updates and recent developments

The first Confab was hosted on August 18th. Over 50 people had registered.

Focus topic

Debrief on the August Confab

The committee and the team thanked Marie-Ange for being a great host for the confab. Ruva shared positive experiences of the breakout rooms she had been placed in. Scott reported that over 50 people had registered for the event through the promotional work that Shamah and Ruva had done. He explained to the community that the team is learning how to promote the events to increase attendance. Since the event was the first one ever hosted, the next one will be better coordinated and promoted.



Despite the limited time to network during the breakout session, Ruva and Shamah connected with a lady who works for Enactus which is a company that works with students who are entrepreneurs. The committee agreed that the time given to breakouts was limited and it was unfortunate that the breakouts ended abruptly.

The committee suggested that the breakouts have a countdown timer when the session is about to end so that the attendees can conclude. Dustie explained that most people log out of the meeting when it was time for breakout rooms, the committee suggested that the host explains what the attendee should be doing in the breakout rooms to avoid confusion and for better flow of the program.

During the week of the promotion of the Confab there was raise in the number of Portal visits, Scott highlighted. The new content is increasing traffic and growing the ELISA following.

Kemoy let the committee know that she will be reverting to the speakers about the briefing call and confirmed the time with the team. She suggested asking for the speaker biography during the briefing call instead of sending a separate email. Scott suggested that Kemoy copy the ICPD team on the emails.

Other & Action Items

ICPD to meet with the confirmed speakers in preparation for the event ICPD to provide to attendees in advance all Confabs - a Bootstrap Brief and questions for the networking breakouts.
