- Focus topics
  - ELISA Business Scholars (EBS) program Training Session 12-14 November 2024, in Hwange, Zimbabwe (arrival in Victoria Falls)
    - EBS Scholars over 400 applicants received; 75 met the quantitative criteria and are being reviewed by the selection committee; 20 volunteers on the selection committee, each member is using the qualitative criteria online to review 10 applications with a goal to complete their work by 15 September; will be admitting 15 scholars; the 75 being reviewed represent 17 unique sectors, 15 countries, and they are 45% female and 65% male
    - Coaches We need eight coaches to be at the EBS training sesion in-person; <u>online Call for Coaches</u> with online application; they are leaders with business expertise; review and provide suggestions the <u>list of prospective coaches</u>; for the first year, ICPD will cover the airport transfers, meals, beverages and lodging for the coaches (\$850 value per person)
    - Agenda Discussion about the <u>draft agenda</u>; the goals for the program are:
      - Include high-level sessions on key business disciplines, ie finance, marketing, operations, accounting
      - Gap analysis of Scholars' knowledge in key business disciplines
      - Sustainability of business models
      - Network and connect with other like-minded businesses across the continent and locate funding sources
    - Speakers some of the Coaches and Advisory Council members will also serve as speakers; seek a moderator who has both entrepreneurial and academic business expertise; Speakers needs document and Call for Speakers with online application
    - Advisory Council meeting on 12 November in Hwange Zimbabwe; all members are encouraged to attend in-person
