- Attendees - 30 entrepreneurs from across Africa. Applicants will compete for full fellowships to be part of the year-long Scholars Program; 15 executives (in-person or remote) serving as mentors/business coaches

- Structure/agenda - arrive Tues, full day of programming Wed & Thurs, depart Fri; followed by monthly virtual meetings between coaches and scholars for 12 months
- Speakers - coaches, experts on bootstrapping businesses in Africa
- Sponsorship - ICPD needs at least 6 sponsored scholars to break-even financially; ICPD is working with the ELISA development committee to develop objectives for sponsors
