- ELISA Summit Committee update (Marie-Ange Noue, Chair), last meeting was 23 October 2024
 - ELISA Business Scholars (EBS) program Training Session 12-14 November 2024, in Hwange, Zimbabwe (arrival in Victoria Falls)
 - It was part of a broader ELISA Summit
 - Kicked off with a Reception & Dinner to Celebrate Enterprise Leaders & Innovators, opening remarks were presented by a representative from the Zimbabwe Ministry of Information
 - Attended by two Advisory Council members Kemoy Liburd-Chow (USA) and Anesu Chikumba (Zimbabwe)
 - We were able to refine the training format and establish an engaging curriculum that benefitted both the Scholars and the Coaches
 - Scholars also had the opportunity to visit Victoria Falls
 - EBS Scholars 12 Scholars were admitted, representing 7 sectors and 10 countries, 40% were female and 60% were male; attendee information page is here: <u>https://elisanetwork.com/attend/</u> the listing of the Scholars cohort is here: <u>https://elisanetwork.com/scholar-cohorts/</u>; over 500 applicants received

Coaches - 6 coaches participated in the entire training session coaching each coach was paired with 2 ELISA Scholars; they are leaders with business expertise; for the first year, ICPD will cover the airport transfers, meals, beverages and lodging for the coaches (\$850 value per person) **The Final agenda** can be viewed here

- ELISA Portal Committee update (Chudi Obiaya, Chair), last meeting was 22 October 2024
 - Focus Topics:
 - Objectives for the ELISA portal the committee recommended these goals for consideration:
 - Increase web engagement (stickiness)
 - Networking with others
 - Seek and engage entrepreneurs
 - Future committee meetings structure meet quarterly, rely on Whatsapp group for ongoing committee work; committee should focus on giving staff guidance on prioritisation of portal work
 - o Updates, past action items, and recent developments
 - Web traffic report
 - Portal enhancements
 - ELISA Scholars additional resources were added to support ELISA Scholars selection process, coaching application and guidelines and attendee information; the portal will support the one-year ELISA Scholar/Coach Action plan which includes goals and action steps; a page was also added listing the profiles for the 2024 ELISA Scholars
 - Registration for the portal more links to join added and process being streamlined
 - Project pages and events shareable
 - Allow Project page owners to see who has viewed their project
 - Portal selection tool completed and will be used for the selection of the ELISA Scholars cohort, Membership Outreach Coordinator and the ELISA Advisory Council
 - Event videos links for past sessions being added to the portal and social media pages

 - Enhancements for Project Page functionality to include posting of resources and opportunities, including miscellaneous posts by category (ie - funding opportunities, services, goods, etc.). Aspects to consider are curation, security, and posting by staff of resources
 - User experience and usability testing (UI/UX)
 - Data about the entrepreneurs on the EBN (who they are and what they need?)
 - Crowd funding for project pages (with feedback system) & general donations to ELISA – what features should be built and how should it work?
 - Member onboarding process
 - Website optimization for mobile devices

- ELISA Development Committee update (Scott May, Acting Chair), last meeting was 24 October 2024 o Focus topics
 - Defining the ELISA strapline Staff will recommend a final strapline to the Advisory Approval; ICPD has polled Advisory Council members about possible straplines and received input from the Development Committee
 - Chair for the Development Committee
 - Marketing of the Confabs Messaging being changed to emphasize networking and practical tips from the speakers; the committee recommended past attendees be asked to follow the ELISA social media accounts and repost marketing messages about upcoming Confabs; results of survey from past attendees; overview of current marketing strategy and recommendations on how best to market to new attendees
 - Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) ELISA KPIs currently reflect the mission, vision and strategy of the program and track the programmatic elements and budgetary impact of ELISA; Staff to next report on the KPIs in June 2025; Over time we should be able track the impact of ELISA on the broader impact goals; The broader impact goals are:
 - success of entrepreneurs
 - impact on the broader entrepreneurial ecosystem in Africa
 - what impact does ELISA have on the entrepreneurs?
 - what is the growth of companies involved with ELISA?
 - what is the program's reach and effectiveness?
 - Other/Future action items
 - New leads for corporate and affiliate members
 - Value proposition for Corporate (\$3400/yr) and Affiliate membership (\$349/yr) – Collateral materials being finalized and will be posted on the website
