- Debrief about the 2024 SMDP Biotech training program, June 1-6, San Diego
 - Agenda Summary of program evaluation responses; for future programs ICPD will send the program evaluations to participant's cell phones near the end of the training session; two sessions were conducted virtually in advance of the in-person training session; thanks to Pfizer for hosting the drug discovery game once again it was well received; in future programs ICPD will add concurrent sessions where the scholars will receive mentoring portal training while the mentors will discuss their plans for the virtual mentoring year
 - Scholars 108 scholars sponsored; pairing of scholars and mentors worked well; post-training virtual portal orientation
 - Mentors 82 in-person mentors, 4 stand-in mentors in-person and 26 virtual mentors; 15 of the 26 virtual mentors joined 1:1 meetings; the virtual 1:1 session worked well but the scholars need to bring headphones or ear buds to lower the sound volume in the room; for the scholars whose mentors did not attend the in-person or virtual 1:1 sessions, then ICPD doubled those scholars with another onsite mentor; mentors who can't attend in-person should be available for virtual 1:1 sessions
 - Venues all worked well; the Social Tap informal opening event set a record attendance, and not having a keynote speaker or presentations allowed for more networking; InterContinental San Diego was an excellent facility for the training and having two separate break-out rooms made these sessions more interactive; mentors from the same companies were split amongst the breakout rooms and this kept the sessions balanced
 - Celebration of Mentoring and Diversity Reception Not having a keynote speaker or presentations allowed for more networking; it was good having a photographer on board and a group photo should be added for the future events
 - Site visit to Johnson & Johnson La Jolla Campus Thanks to J&J for hosting the event; the scholars were divided into three groups and those were rotated between lab tours, networking with J&J employees and a company presentation
 - Group size Conducted two concurrent sessions of 50-60 scholar/mentor pairs and this worked well; for future programs ICPD will add QR codes to name badges to allow for efficient registration at events



- BIO International Convention ICPD is grateful to BIO for its support and recognition of SMDP during the convention; the scholars and SMDP were showcased during a Super Session (keynote); the scholars were invited to attend the diversity luncheon; the Women in Bio group hosted the scholars for a speed networking session; for future conventions ICPD will strive to have the BIO events on separate days during the convention
