Scientist Mentoring & Diversity Program for MedTech (SMDP MedTech)

October 4-8, 2014 in Chicago, Illinois

What is SMDP MedTech?

The one year career mentoring program pairs ethnically diverse graduate students and post-doctoral researchers with industry mentors who work at medtech companies.

With their mentors, Scholars attend a 5-day training session to learn about career opportunities in industry and receive career development coaching. They also attend AdvaMed 2014: *The MedTech Conference.*

What experience is required to become a mentor?

- Mentors must be currently employed in a leadership position at a medical technology company
- To become a mentor, you should be nominated by a human resource representative from your company or a member of your company's executive staff

Are mentors also minorities?

Mentors can be any ethnicity.

What commitments are mentors making?

- Attend an orientation call prior to the SMDP MedTech training session
- Meet in person with your mentee and attend the entire SMDP MedTech training session Oct. 4-6, 2014 in Chicago
- Communicate with your mentee by phone, in person or through email. The frequency is suited to your mentor and mentee relationship and typically requires no more than 1-3 hours monthly.
- Mentoring continues for one year after the training session
- Provide communication or updates for the continued improvement of the program

How do companies select staff as mentors?

ICPD provides participating companies with a mentor recruitment flyer, which is typically distributed by human resources or communications departments to all qualified staff within the company.
